RULES AND GUIDELINES

- 1- Animals, weapons, illegal substances, explosives, fireworks, alcohol, drugs, drug paraphernalia, pornography, tobacco and dangerous materials are not permitted.
 - 2- Males and females shall not be in the sleeping quarters of anyone of the opposite sex at any time unless an adult is present.
 - 3- Do not bring clothing with tobacco/alcohol slogans or with suggestive sayings. If you are unsure don't bring it.
 - 4- Electronic devices (MP3 players, video games, portable DVD players, etc) are not allowed. If you are found with one, it will be held until you get home.
 - 5- Do not bring/wear clothing that is too short, too tight, or revealing. If you decided to wear something too short, too tight or revealing, you will be asked to change or put on one another item of clothing that Phil will provide.
 - 6- Swim Suits – We might have the opportunity to use the pool at the YMCA. Girls must wear one piece bathing suits, or wear a non-white t-shirt over their suits.
 - 7- Cell phones may be brought, but with the following rules: No texting (unless given permission by the leaders)! One phone call home when we arrive at our destination, one in the middle of the week and one when we are almost home. The purpose of the trip is to get away from the things that distract us. It also is to help us become dependent on each other.
 - 8- Pranks of any sort will not be tolerated.
 - 9- RESPECT ONE ANOTHER AND THEIR THINGS.

These rules and guidelines are an affirmation of our concern for the well being of the total community. Please understand that a serious infraction of the rules means you will be disciplined and/or may mean you will be sent home at your parent's expense.

1. One Suit Case
2. One Carry On or Back Pack for use in the vehicles
3. Sleeping bag, pillow, air mattress (No Double or Queen sized unless sharing)
4. Towels (2 are recommended)
5. Personal Hygiene Items (want a carrying case for showers at the YMCA)
6. Work Clothes (don't mind if they get dirty) – shorts are fine
7. Clothes for the evening – it can get cool in the evening – so bring a jacket or hoodie
8. Swim Suit (see Rules and Guidelines Sheet)
9. Work Gloves
10. Closed Toed Shoes for work sites. Flip Flops and Crocs are OK for free time
11. Water Bottle
12. Sun Screen (we do have some in our emergency kit)
13. Bible

17. Spending Money – We have a allowance for meals on the road \$6 for lunch and \$8 for dinner. Spending money is for extras that you might need, and to get mementos of the trip.
